## NOAA Corps Officers & Captain



- Salary- \$45,000-\$120,000, plus pension
- Job Description– Assume leadership roles in the operation of the ship
- Required Training– Bachelor of Science from an accredited university with a minimum of 48 credit hours of science

## Engineer



- Salary- \$95,000-\$200,000
- Job Description- Maintain engine room, logs, and records
- Required Training– Bachelors in Engineering or on-the-job training

## Fishing & Deck Crew



- Salary- \$40,000-\$100,000
- Job Description– Fishing, operating deck equipment, watch standing on the bridge, chipping and painting, keeping the vessel clean, and driving the RHIB
- Required Training- Must meet Coast Guard requirements (Able Bodies Seaman), mostly done by on-the-job training (More training is required to move up to get a Captain's license.)

## Scientist



- Salary- \$30,000-\$150,000, depending on level of expertise
- Job Description- Collecting and analyzing data, interpreting findings, publishing results
- Required Training- Bachelor of Science from an accredited university

## Electronics Technician



- Salary- \$47,500-\$68,000
- Job Description- Perform preventive and corrective maintenance and installations on all the various types of electronic equipment and systems
- Required Training– 1 year of specialized experience (internship) or 18 or more collegiate hours

## Steward



- Salary- \$37,500-\$47,500
- Job Description– Provide a well balanced and nutritious menu, ensure all sanitation regulations are met, order and receive food stores
- Required Training- Junior College– Basics of Cooking and Baking, Nutrition, Safe Serve Certification (Bachelors in Culinary Art increases salary)
